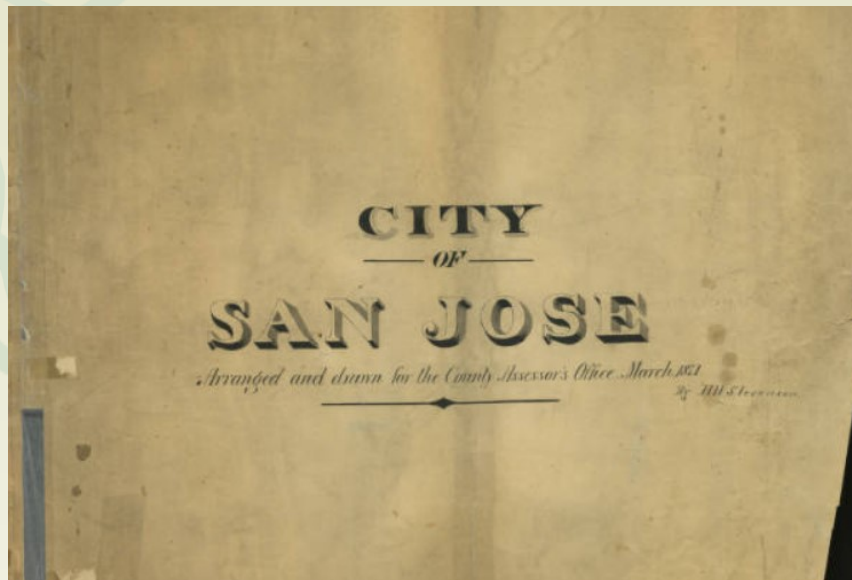

Research Report Frank Cesena's Family

Research Object: Determine accurate lineage for Frank Cesena and his 2 siblings, Lola Cesena and Soledad Cesena who married a Cavilli. Also determine if the family came from Baja Sur Mexico.

Information Provided: Frank Cesena, 1875-1929 married Lula Parks and had four children—Myrtle, Lester, Ernest and Francis. The Cesena family lived in California. Family lore says that the Cesenas were from Baja Sur in Lower California. Available online family trees show Frank as the son of 2 different men, Cipriano Cesena with his wife Mary Weeks and Jose Maria Cesena with his wife Jusus Alviso. Family tradition states that Frank is the son of Ramon Cesena and his wife Soledad Sepada, Soledad may have gone by Jenny. Frank had 2 sisters, known aunts in the family, Soledad who went by Salli, and Lola who did not marry.

Research Results: Ramon Sotero Cesena, Cipriano Cesena and Jose Maria Cesena were brothers and sons of Francisco Cesena and Dolores Aviles / Abiles. It follows tradition each son likely would have named one of their sons after their own father; in this case anglicized Frank for Francisco. Frank, the son of Cipriano and Frank, the son of Jose Maria have both been proven to not be the Frank Cesena that married Lula Parks and had sisters Lola and Soledad.

During the research we have also added a 3rd sister to Frank, Lola, and Salli, the previously unknown Selena / Salome.

Soledad Sepeda / Zepeda was the first wife of Ramon Sotero Cesena, she likely passed away before 1880 when the 4 children are found living with "Pera Garmil". Ramon remarries about 1883 to Jenny / Jennie Ojeda, together they have 5 children.

Additional confusion comes being 2 Ramon Cesenas being in the San Jose area at the in the late 1800s.

Ramon Sotero Cesena that married Soldedad Zepada / Sepeda is not the Ramon Cesena that married Merced Gomez in 1870, as has been cited in numerous online trees. These 2 Ramons

Research Results Continued: are listed separately in the 1870 Census. Ramon Sisena with Soledad in San Jose, and Ramon Cescina with his 2 young children in Burnett. Through California voter registrations the two separate Ramon Cesenas are frequently listed on the same page for Santa Clara County; Ramon Sotero with his middle name included.

With the discovery of the 1880 US Federal Census where the 4 siblings (Frank, Lola, Soledad and Selena) are listed as living with their grandmother, "Pera Garmil" the question became who is this Pera Garmil. Ramon Sotero's parents had both passed away by 1880, which eliminated them. Soledad's father had passed away as well, but her mother Carmela (Carmel or Carmen) Sepeda (Zepeda or Sepetha) was still alive.

Looking back 10 years we find Carmela Sepetha is living next to Ramon and Soledad in the 1870 census along with Carmela's younger children. The known birthdate for Carmela is 19 Sep 1827, not 1810 as is listed in the 1880 Census. Carmela's birth year is also listed incorrectly in the 1870 Census as 1835. Frequently, this type of error is due to children reporting their parents ages.

It is possible the census taker spoke to one of the children when he came to the house and Pera Garmil is a very poorly understood Pera for Zepeda and Carmel for Garmil. It is also possible that the census taker asked the children Grandma's age and an approximate was provided. When the Soundex is used the numerical value for Carmel is 2654 (C654) and the numerical value for Garmil is also 2654 (G654). The numerical breakdown for Zepeda is 213 (Z13) and numerical value for Pera is 16 (P6), which is not the same, however if you drop the "Ze" in Zepeda and compare just Peda the numerical value becomes 13 (P3). While not concrete proof that "Pera Garmil" is Carmel Zepeda this evidence combined with known land ownership makes us fairly certain of this connection.

Additional information includes the known death date of Carmela being 27 Jun 1893 in San Jose, Santa Clara County, California. A thorough search of the 1880 Census does not find Carmela listed anywhere else in 1880 in Santa Clara County.

Research Results Continued:

The most conclusive confirmation of “Pera Garmil” being Carmel Zepeda comes from the address of “Pera Garmil” and the known land ownership maps from San Jose. This entire area was owned by the Sepeda / Zepeda family, finding Sepeda grandchildren at this location leaves Carmela Martinez Zepeda as the matriarch of the family at this location and the most likely grandmother listed with the 4 children.

It has been confirmed, by baptismal records, that the family was in Baja Sur as Ramon Sotero Cesena was baptized there. Whether this was the origin of the family or he was baptized as they were immigrating has not been established.

With family lore confirmed we include family group sheets that add additional information to the Zepeda / Martinez / Cesena family.

Details of the research follow. Included is research on all 3 first cousins with the name Frank Cesena. A great deal of records are available in California. Research is presented first by type and then in chronological order, as much as the record discovery and relevance allows. The research includes both determining the correct Frank Cesena, untangling the questions of marriages of Ramon Cesena as well as determining the correct Ramon Cesena. Once correct individuals were determined additional information on each person is presented.

Marriage Ramon Sotero Cesena and Soledad Sepeda

Two records are available representing the same date in differing years.

Ramon Cesena and Soledad Sepeda were married 15 Feb 1867 in Santa Clara County, California.

Marriage Cipriano Cesena and Mary Weeks (Brother of Ramon Sotero Cesena. Father of Frank F Cesena b. 5 Aug 1885)

No marriage record located for Cipriano Cesena and Mary Weeks. A Mary Weeks is living in the household of Lutana Bosca in the 1860 San Jose Census. In the 1870 Almaden, Santa Clara County census (below) Mary and Cipriano were listed by her maiden name, which is not unusual for Hispanic families. Their eldest daughter is 9. Inferred marriage date of late 1860 early 1861. Cipriano is spelled Sepriano, there are a number of spellings for his name.

Cipriano Cesena and Mary Weeks cannot be found in the 1880 US Census under the surname Cesena or Weeks. A hand search of Almaden, where the family was living in 1870, yields no results. A search of each of their children in 1880 also yields no results. This may simply mean they were missed in the 1880 Census or they may have been in transition while moving.

1900 San Francisco District 87 Census Cipriano Cesena and Mary Weeks (Cipriano brother of Ramon Sotero)

Hand search for Cipriano and Mary Cesena in the 1900 San Francisco Census based on the last known address of S 15th Avenue between P and Q, yields many family members, but no Cipriano and Mary Cesena.

Son Cipriano Jr. and his wife Eva Cesena are living with their children at 1883 15th Avenue. Cipriano Jr. is a tanner.

Cipriano's Sr.'s son Michael is living around the corner at 1840 16th Avenue. Another son of Cipriano Sr.'s is living with Michael, John Cesena is listed as a Boarder.

Cipriano Sr.'s brother Ramon Sotero Cesena is living nearby with his 2nd wife Jennie and their 5 children at 1877 15th Avenue.

1900 San Jose Ward 4, Santa Clara County (Jose Maria Cesena brother of Cipriano and Ramon Sotero, Jose Maria's son Frank Dionysius born 8 Apr 1876)

Cipriano's brother Jose Maria is living in Ward 4 and Jose has a son Frank listed as born 1877. This Frank cannot be the Frank in question as he does not have sister Lola, Selena, or Solidad.

Cipriano Sr. is back living in San Jose Ward 4 as a Boarder in 1910, but there is no evidence that he had moved back to San Jose as early as 1900.

It is more likely, although not certain, that Cipriano and Mary (if alive) were living with family in San Francisco.

Frank Cesena b. 5 Aug 1885, son of Cipriano Cesena (Cipriano brother of Ramon Sotero)

The only evidence found for Frank F Cesena son of Cipriano Cesena and Mary Weeks is the California Death Index which lists Frank Cesena born 5 Aug 1885 in California and death 12 Sep 1944 in Alameda County, California. Father's surname: Cesena, mother's surname: Wilkes. Cipriano's son Fred also lists their mother's surname as Wilkes rather than Weeks. Cipriano died in Alameda County in 1919.

1880 US Census: Ward 4, San Jose, Santa Clara, California (Siblings Frank, Lola, Soledad and Selena)

Frank, Lola, and Soledad are located living as the grandchildren of the head of household Pera Garmil along with a previously unknown sister Selena. The surname is spelled "Sesania" which matches other misspellings of Cesena.

Pera Garmil is 70 years old, it says she was born in California as were both of her parents. California, Lower California, Mexico and New Spain can be seen being used interchangeably to describe California. The Treaty of Guadalupe Hildalgo is how many individuals of Mexican or Spanish heritage became US citizens.

Lola is 9, Selena is 7, Frank is 6, and Solidad is 3, all were born in California with both parents listed as being born in California.

The family's address is 636 Market Street San Jose California.

1880 California Voter Registration: Ramon Sotero Cesena Residence & Nativity

Raymon Sotero Cesena age 39 is listed on the Copy of the Great Register of Santa Clara County. Country of Nativity: Mexico. Occupation Merchant. Local Residence San Jose No. 4. Naturalization By Treaty of Guadalupe Hildalgo. Date of Registration October 2, 1880.

A hand search of the full Ward 4 San Jose 1880 US Census shows no Raymon / Ramon / Raymond Cesena in San Jose Ward 4. So while we can say he is recorded as living in Ward 4 of San Jose in 1880 we do not know where he was living specifically.

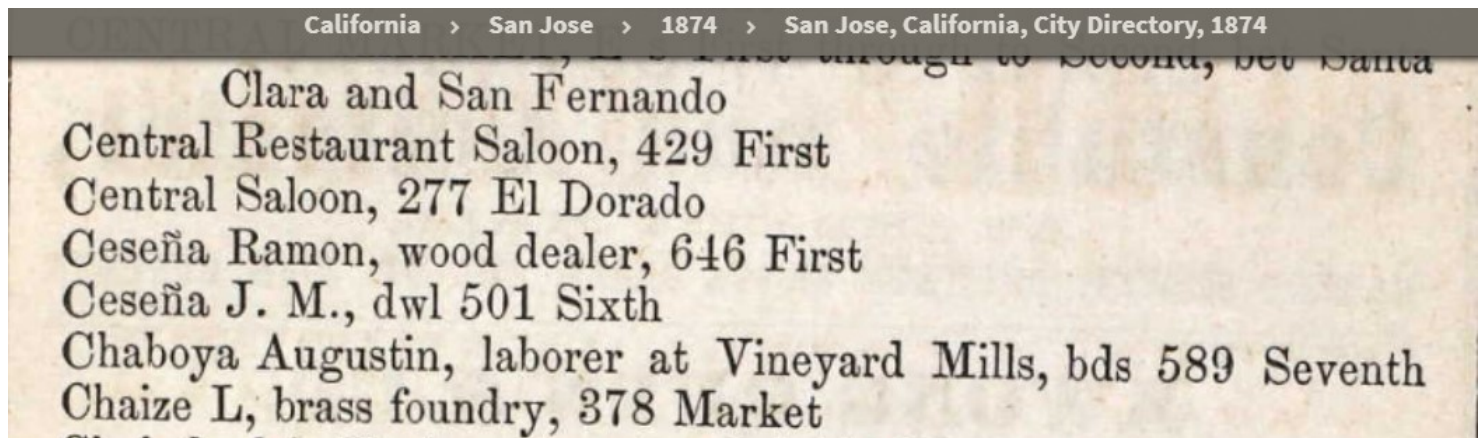

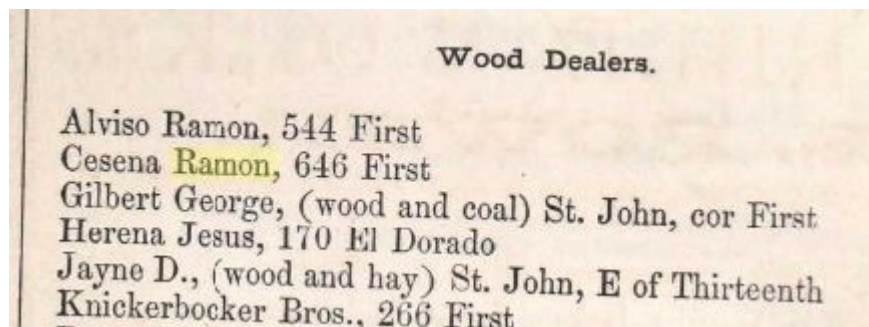

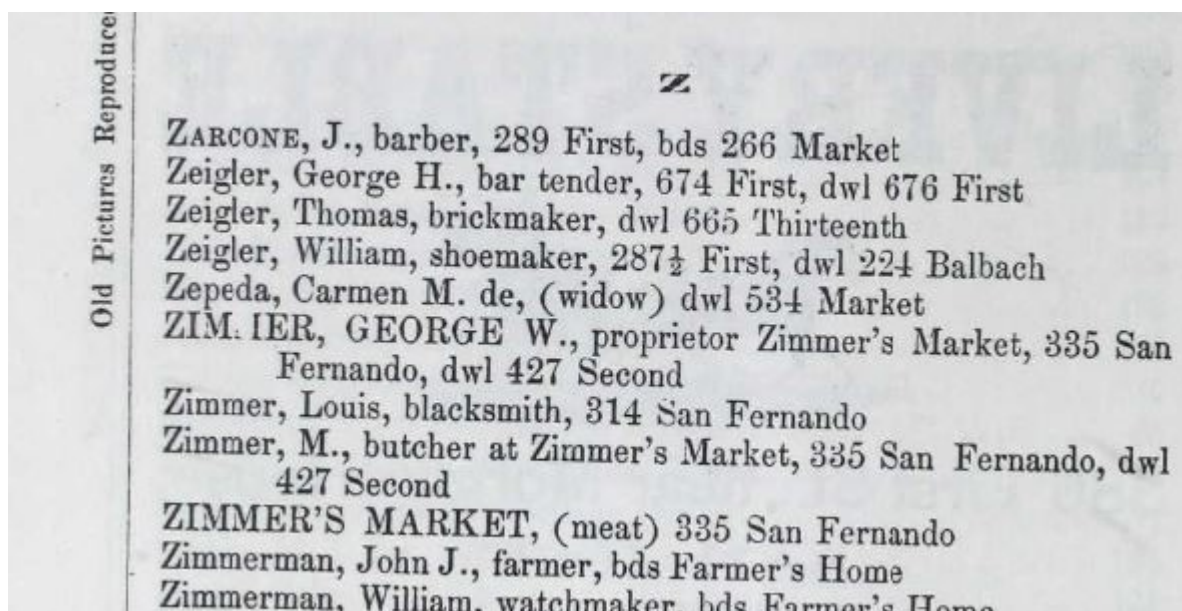

Carmen Zepeda listed as a widow, living at 534 Market Street.

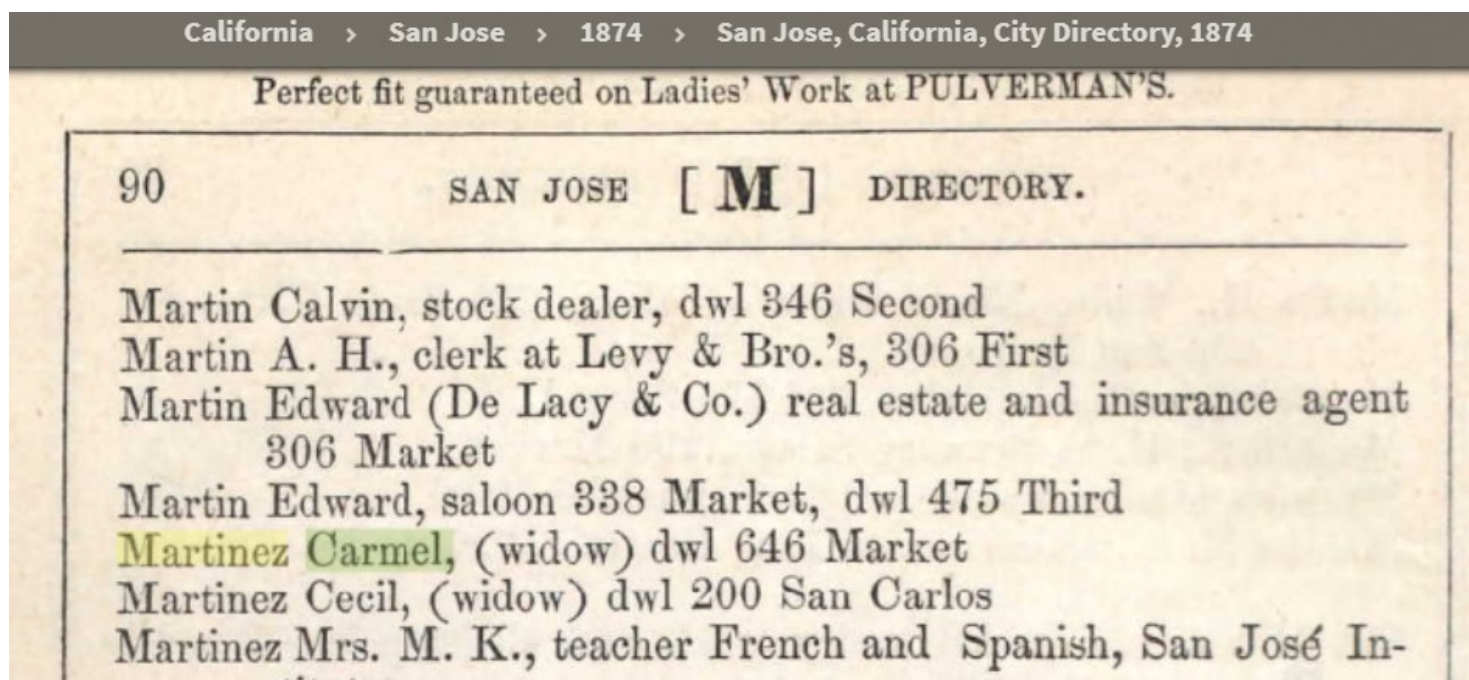

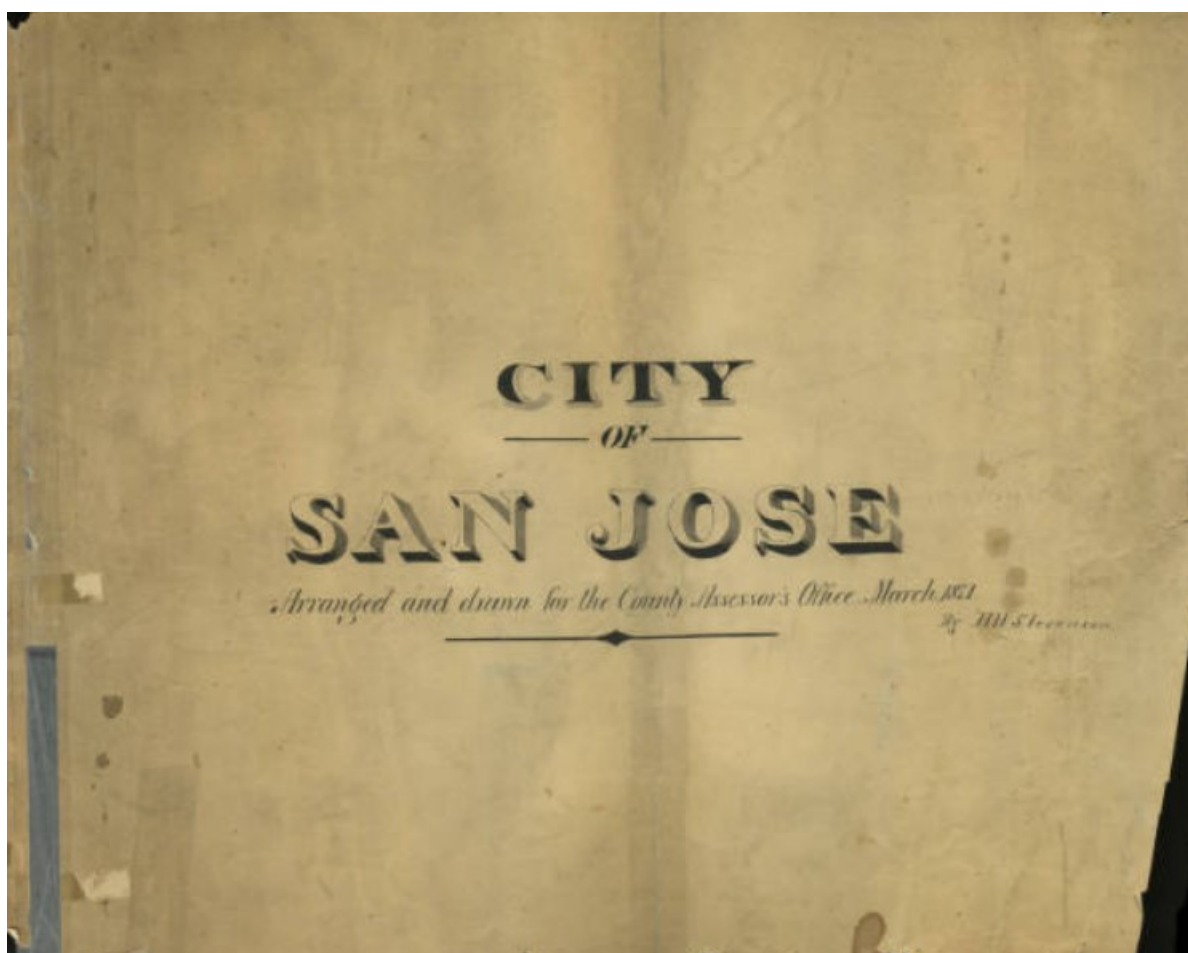
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March 1871 City of San Jose Block Book - Showing Sepada and Cesena Land

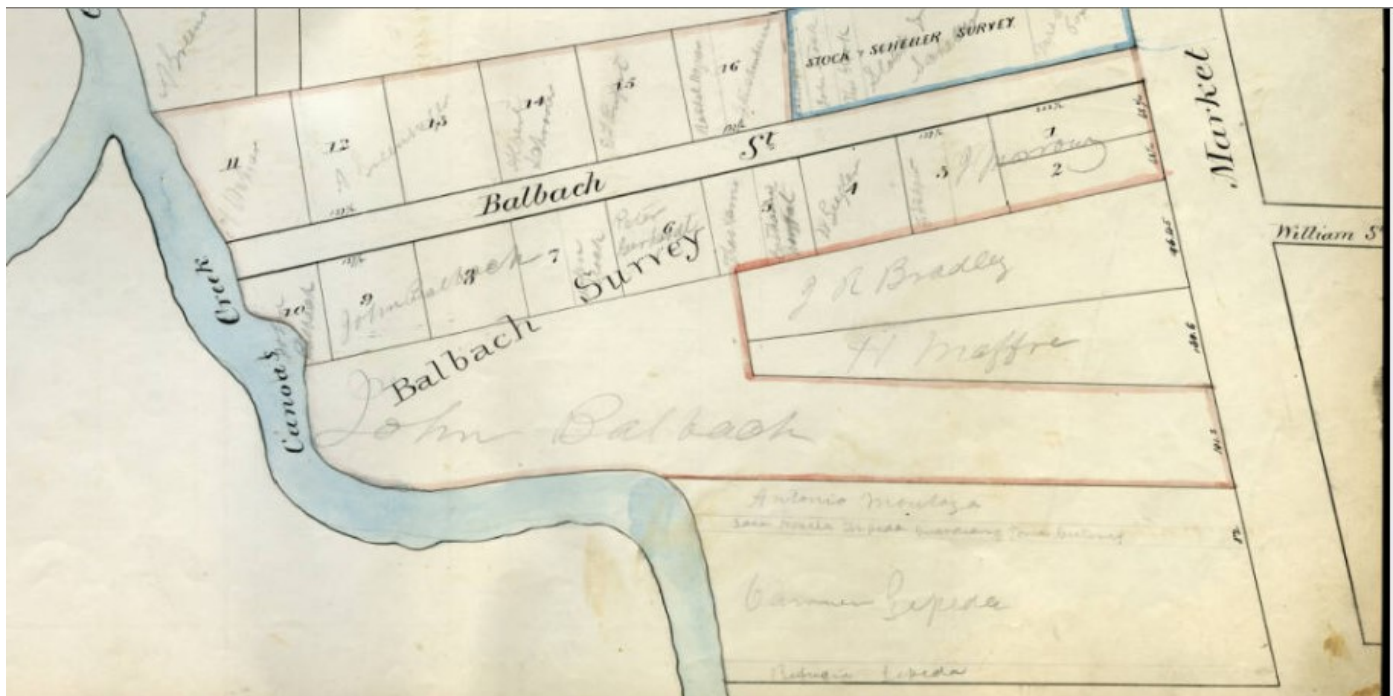


March 1871 City of San Jose Block Book - Showing Sepada Land

March 1871 City of San Jose Block Book - Showing Sepeda Land

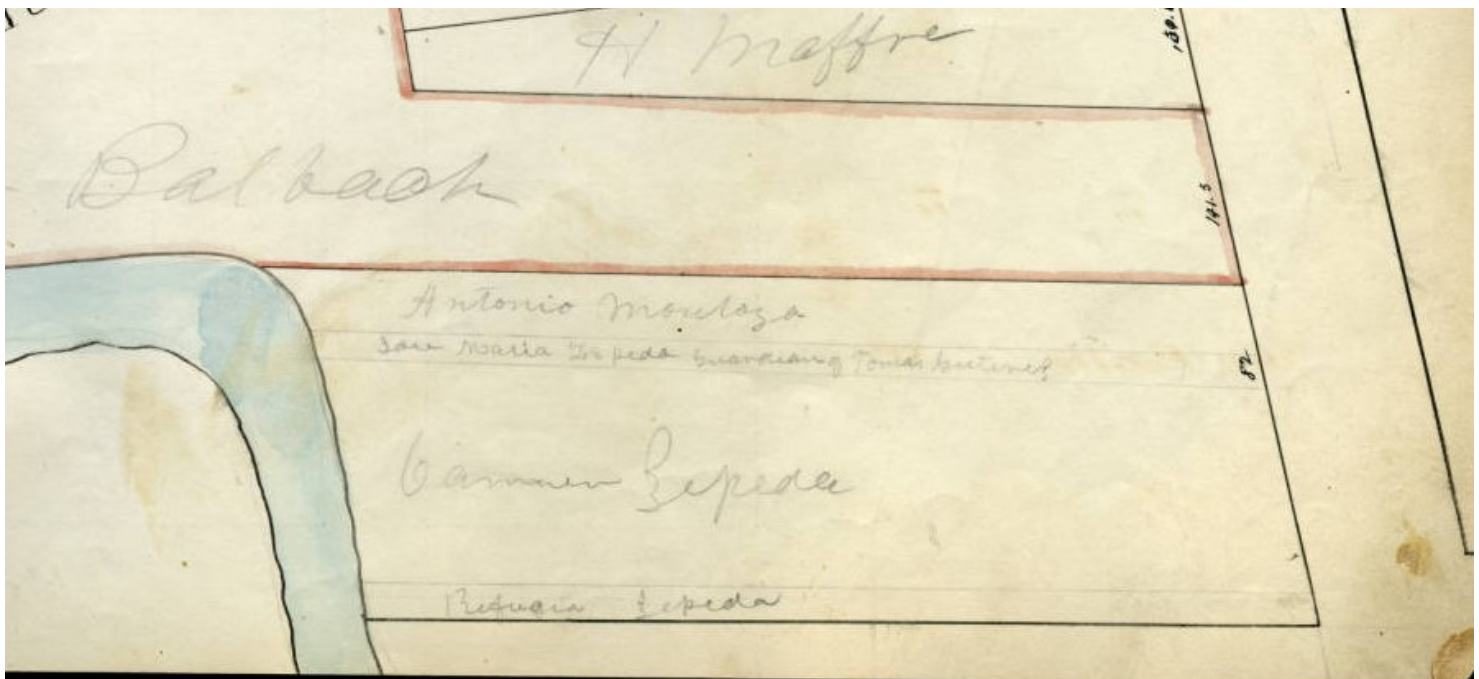
Carmen Sepeda has the largest portion of the land holding.

Refugio Sepeda has the area beneath Carmen's. Refugio is Carmen and Pedro's eldest daughter.

Above Carmen reads "Jose Maria Zepeda Guardian of Tomas Gutierrez" Tomas Gutierrez is Jose Maria Sepeda's nephew and is the grandson of Pedro Sepeda and his first wife Maria Guadalupe Nuno. Carmen Martinez is the second wife for Pedro Sepeda. Tomas's mother was Maria de la Soledad Amada Sepeda who died before 1860. Tomas's father was Julian Gutierrez.

Antonio Montoya has land above Jose Maria Zepeda, Antonio was the husband of Maria Pilar Placida Sepeda 3rd daughter of Carmen and Pedro Sepeda.

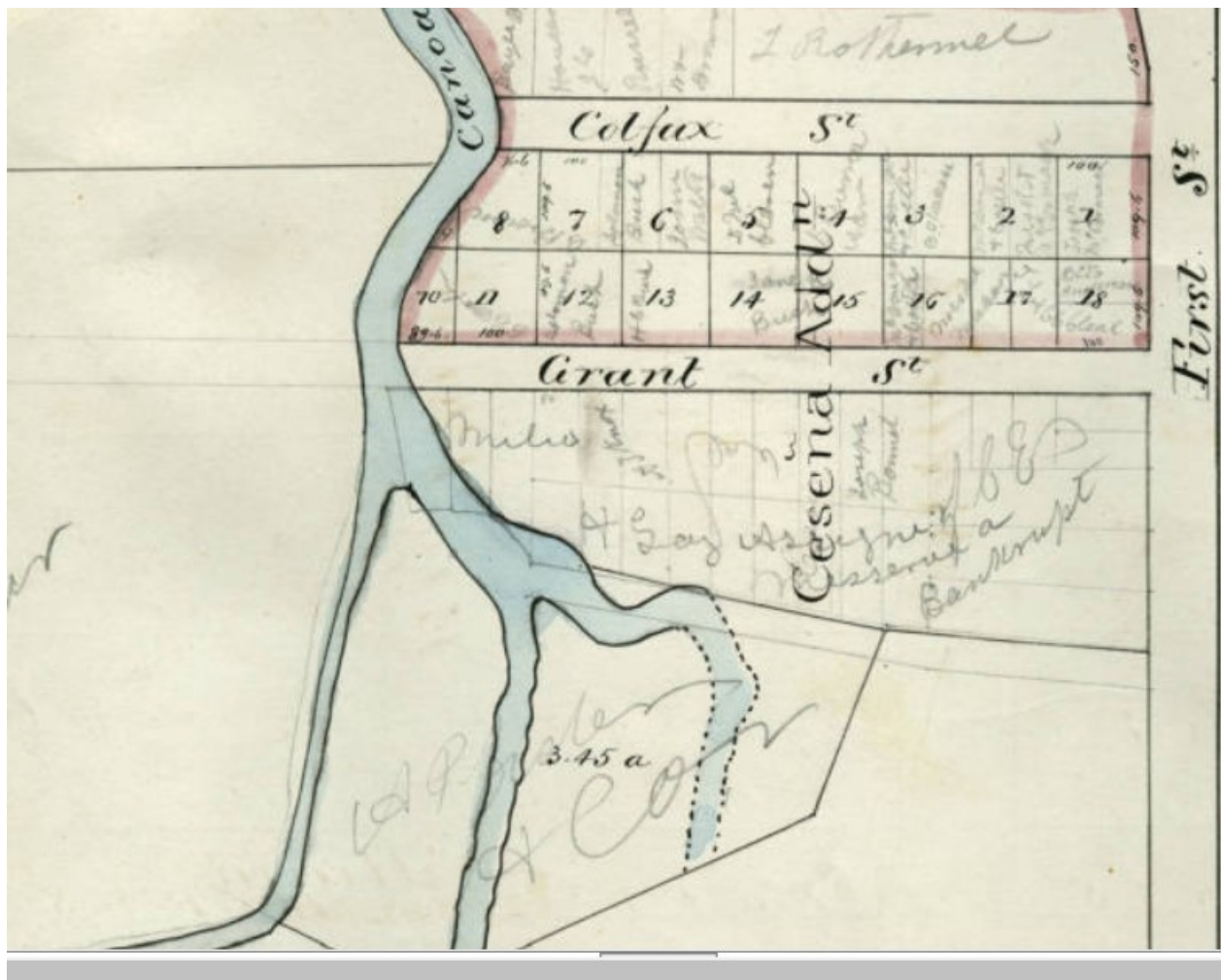


March 1871 City of San Jose Block Book - Showing Cesena Addition

Further down Market Street as it merges and becomes First Street you find the "Cesena Add". Having a plot next to Pedro Sepeda in the 1847 Pueblo San Jose Map, makes it likely that this is the same location from a different perspective. Many areas in this book are noted with original names and are broken up into smaller plots by this time.

Francisco Cesena died in 1853 and his wife Dolores Aviles / Abiles died sometime before 1870. This plot is documented in Francisco Cesena's probate records.

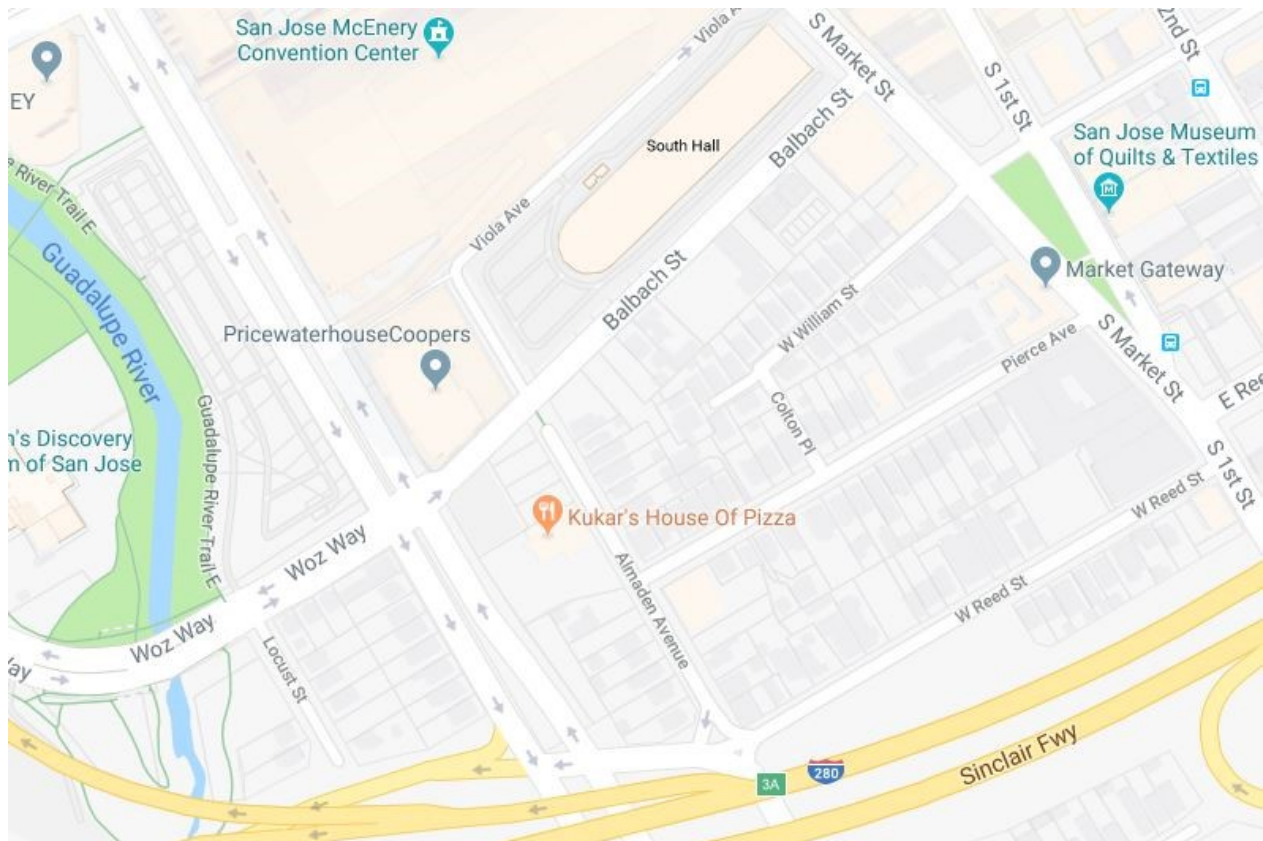
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Market Street and First Street in San Jose in 1818

Santa Clara County Probate Records for Francisco Cesena (father of Ramon Sotero Cesena)

Wife of Francisco Cesena, Dolores Abiles de Cesena, petitioned the court that her husband had died on or about the 6th of April 1853 and that he had died intestate. "Your petitioner further shows that said Dolores Abiles de Cesena is the widow of the said deceased and entitled to the administration of estate, before any other person..."

Dolores Abiles de Cesena petitions the court to be appointed guardian of her children, which allows us to fully document the childrens' names and ages. "The petition of Dolores Abiles de Cesena widow of Francisco Cesena Decd respectfully, sheweth, that said decedent departed this life leaving seven children all of whom are minors as follows, Guadalupe aged 18 years, Jose Maria aged 16 years, Cyprian aged 15 years, Ramon aged 14 years, Maria aged 13 years, Serafina aged 10 years, Antonio aged 8 years. That the three of said children last named are under the age of 14 years, wherefore petitioner prays that she be appointed guardian of the said Maria, Serafina and Antonio according to law." This petition was Witnessed by "Francis Wilks".

Independently the eldest 4 also petition the court to have their mother appointed their guardian.

In the "Inventory and Appraisement of the Real and personal Estate of Francisco Sasana Decd" we find "One half Leage of land \$1000.00" and "10 Acres of land in the City San Jose \$1000.00". The 10 acres is the documented land in the City of San Jose Block book. Furthering this is the payment of City Taxes, "10 acres west of Market Street & South of Zepada Fractional Block South of Base line intersection of Market & First Street & Improvements & personal property".

Domingo Cesena had come in to help take "care of the cattle on the Rancho of said Estate". May 12, 1854 Domingo Cesena declares his allegiance to the United States in the 3rd District Court of Santa Clara County, renouncing all allegiance to the Republic of Mexico.

(There is the possibility that Francisco Cesena is Jose Francisco Anastacio Cesena baptized 17 Nov 1810 San Jose del Cabo, Baja California Sur, Mexico. Son of Cipriano Cesena and Cornelia Castillo. This Jose Francisco had a brother Domingo Cesena. At this time no evidence exists to concretely prove this relationship.)

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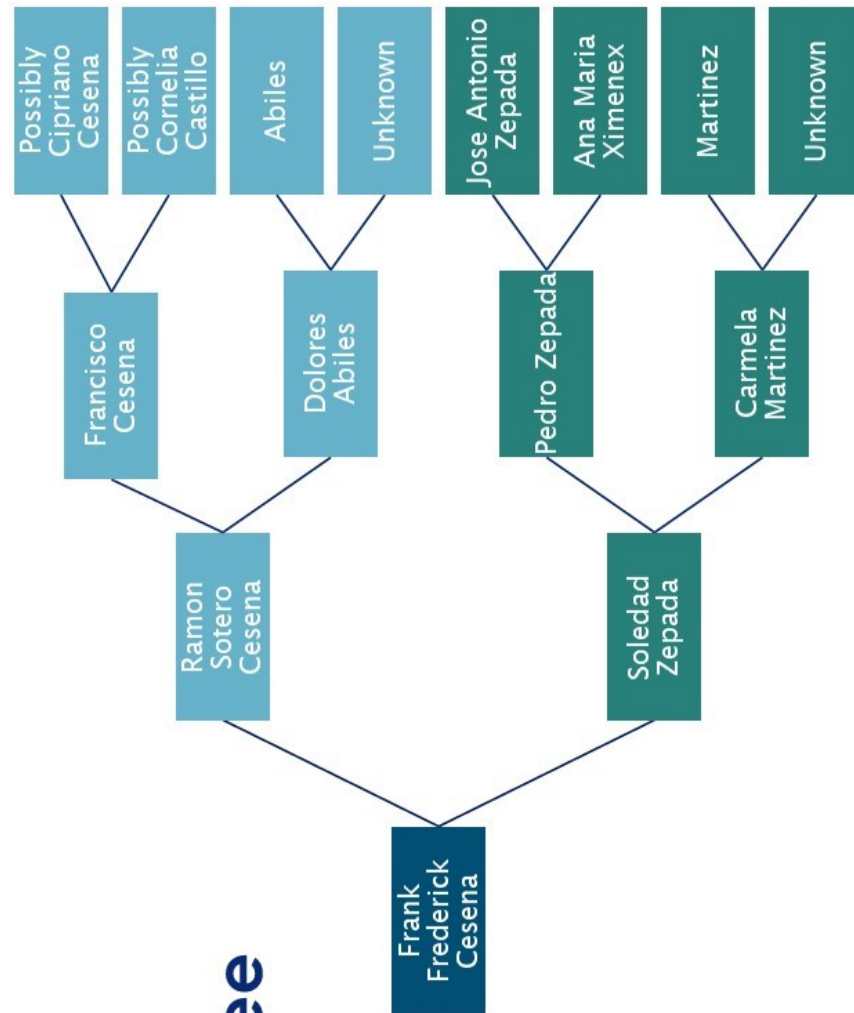

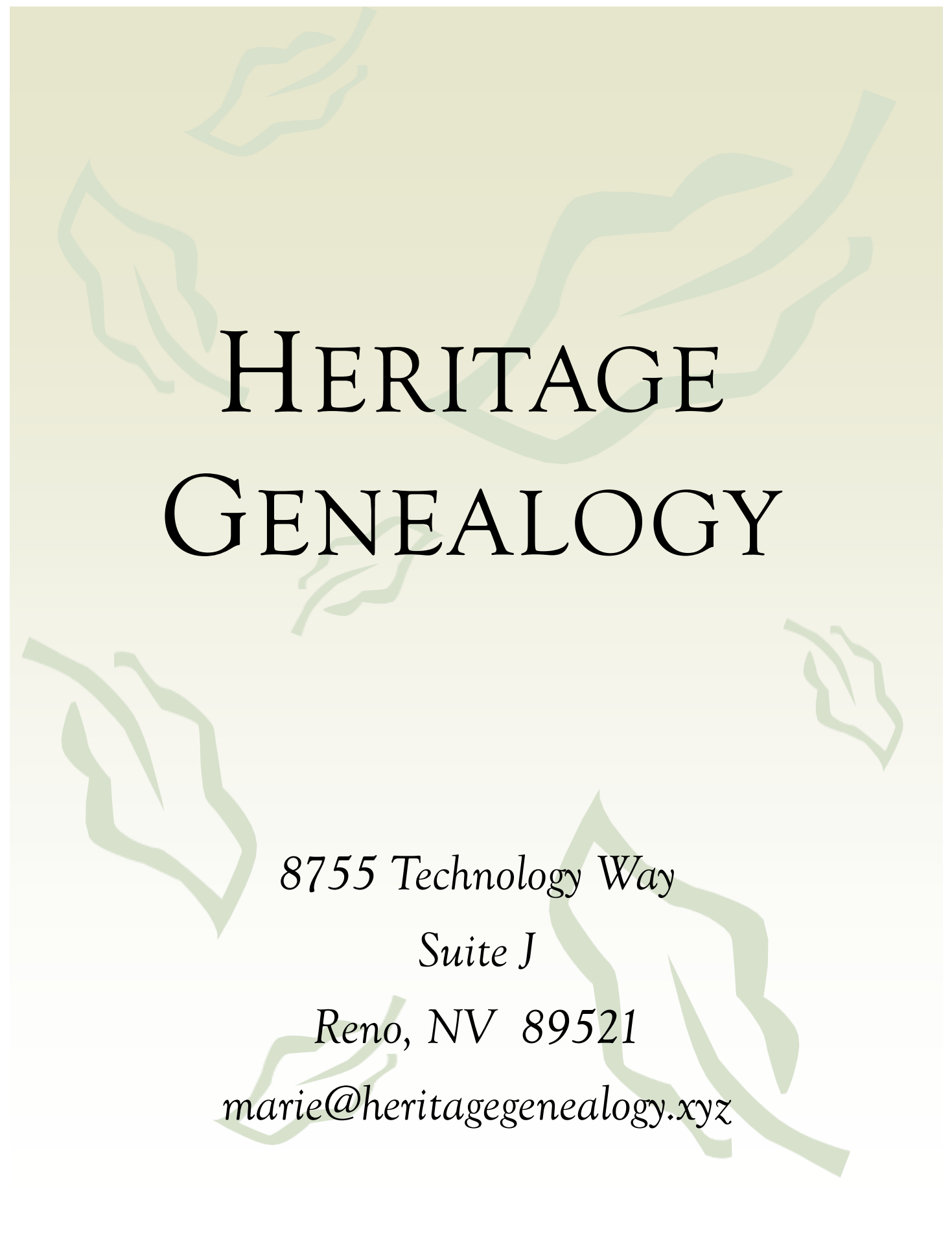
